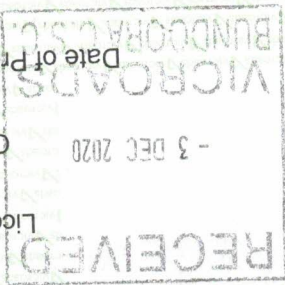

Important information

Notification of medical condition

You must notify VicRoads if you are suffering from any serious (permanent or long-term) illness, disability, medical condition or injury (or the effects of treatment for any of those things) that may impair your ability to drive safely.* Please note that failure to make a required notification is an offence under regulation 68(2) of the Road Safety (Drivers) Regulations 2019. For further information go to vicroads.vic.gov.au.

*Not required if you have recently been medically assessed by VicRoads or are currently having a VicRoads medical review assessment, unless there has been a change to your previously notified condition(s).

Carry your driver licence and/or learner permit while driving

You should carry your driver licence and/or learner permit while driving and produce it upon request to a police officer or a VicRoads Transport Safety Services Officer.

If you cannot produce your driver licence and/or learner permit, you may be fined and incur demerit points if you are:

- driving a large vehicle more than 80km from the vehicle's normal place of business
- a probationary driver licence holder
- a full driver licence holder with a Z condition (zero Blood Alcohol Concentration)
- a full driver licence holder aged under 26.

Licence and registration renewal

It is your responsibility to make sure that your driver licence or learner permit or motor vehicle registration is current. If you drive an unregistered motor vehicle or drive unlicensed, you are committing an offence and may not be covered by insurance – even if you did not receive your renewal notice.

Codes

If any of the following codes are on your driver licence or learner permit, the corresponding condition or licence category applies to you.

Condition codes

- A** You must drive a vehicle with an automatic transmission (except a motorcycle or tractor) when holding a probationary licence or if you have a physical disability that prevents you from driving a vehicle with a manual transmission.
- B** You must drive a heavy vehicle or bus with a synchromesh transmission.
- E** You must not drive a motorcycle unless it is approved under the Learner Approved Motorcycle Scheme (LAMS); must not carry a pillion passenger and must not drive a motorcycle unless the headlights are on at all times before the date appearing after the licence category code R.
- I** You must only drive a motor vehicle fitted with an alcohol interlock.

Licence category codes

- CAR** You may drive a motor vehicle (except a motorcycle) that has a Gross Vehicle Mass (GVM) not more than 4.5 tonnes and seats no more than 12 adults including the driver.
- R** You may ride a two-wheeled motor vehicle (including a motorcycle with trailer, forcar or sidecar attached) or motor trike.
- LR** You may drive any light rigid motor vehicle, including a truck or bus, with a GVM more than 4.5 tonnes, but not more than 8 tonnes; or seats more than 12 adults (including the driver) and has a GVM not more than 8 tonnes.
- MR** You may drive a medium rigid motor vehicle that has a GVM more than 8 tonnes and has no more than 2 axles.
- HR** You may drive a heavy rigid motor vehicle that has a GVM more than 8 tonnes and has 3 or more axles or a bus that has more than one rigid section.
- HC** You may drive a prime mover to which is attached a single semi-trailer that has a GVM more than 9 tonnes plus any unladen converter dolly or a rigid motor vehicle to which is attached a trailer that has a GVM more than 9 tonnes plus any unladen converter dolly.
- MC** You may drive any motor vehicle or combination of vehicles other than a motorcycle.

You must drive a motorcycle with an automatic transmission.

You must wear corrective lenses at all times while driving.

You must only drive a motor vehicle fitted with specified driver aids, or modified as directed in writing by VicRoads.

You must comply with any condition you have been notified of in writing by VicRoads.

You must not drive a motor vehicle with any alcohol in your blood or breath and you must carry your driver licence and/or learner permit at all times while driving or in charge of a motor vehicle.
